Following in the tradition of the first Teacher Trainings that Susan Harper offered with Emilie Conrad, this 7 day class allows

- teachers-in-training to learn, play and move together and to share in the initiation of teaching each other.
- This will be a safe environment to explore the challenges of stepping into the teaching role and to allow that process to be tended. Each segment of preparing a class will be practiced and discussed from making meaning through words to demonstrating through movement, from creating and teaching lay-outs to managing group dynamics.
- In the event you are ready for the next step, this training prepares to you present a class in front of an ad hoc Review Pod of CTA teachers at a teacher gathering.
- Alternatively this training can provide the video of your teaching for review by your mentors in the Continuum Teacher Association.

While the Foundations of Continuum 14 day training is highly recommended in order to bring an understanding of the history and breadth of Continuum practices, it is possible that this training may be taken by itself with recommendation your mentors.

Gael Rosewood met and studied with Ida Rolf, the founder of Rolfing in 1969. She still maintains a her practice with this modality.

In 1978 she met Emilie Conrad and became an instant devotee of this form of inquiry and exploration. Gael taught for the Rolf Inst. for 15 years, training practitioners in both Rolfing and Rolfing Movement. In 1998 she retired from that endeavor in order to devote her teaching time to Continuum.

She has taught in Europe, Japan, and many places in the US., as well as co-teaching with Emilie. As she enters her elder years, she is hoping to play a part in launching the next generation of Continuum teachers.

Patricia von Weichs runs a private practice for bodywork since 1997. She has extensive training in Rolfing Structural Integration and Rolfing Movement and has assisted for years in the Basic Rolfing Training in Europe.

2007 she began studying with Emilie Conrad, became a Wellsprings Practitioner(2007) and later a Continuum Teacher(2012).



She has also studied Prenatal Psychology with William Emerson and trained in Craniosacral Biodynamics with Franklyn Sills. In her work she explores different modalities and how they can cross-fertilize.
